

The Benefits of the Basic Competency Programme (BCP)

What is BCP?

BCP is a means of delivering construction skills training which is measured against nationally recognised standards.

What are the benefits of BCP to the roofing contractor?

- The Dryseal Training Course is fully approved by the Roofing Industry Alliance and has been vetted by the National Federation of Roofing Contractors (NFRC).
- The BCP is endorsed by the Construction Industry Training Board (CITB) and CSCS.
- Companies can use BCP to help towards NVQ and CSCS qualifications.
- Costs of up to £150 per employee trained can be recovered from the CITB as a grant.
- BCP can help reinforce a company's commitment to training the next generation of roofers.

What are the benefits of BCP to the materials manufacturer?

- It allows the manufacturer to play a meaningful part in a national training scheme which is widely recognised in the construction industry.
- It enables the manufacturer to assist his customers in developing skills within his workforce and enhance the strengths and standing of their organisation.
- The manufacturer can make a direct contribution to skills levels within a customer's workforce and in turn, help improve the quality of completed works on site.

What are the benefits of BCP to the trainee?

- BCP can help individuals to begin a National Vocational Qualification (NVQ) and is a first step towards a Construction Skills Certification Scheme (CSCS) card.
- Trainees can enhance their skills and improve general trade knowledge.
